2. Qualifications of Applicant

2.1 General Qualifications

1) Successfully complete High School in the Science stream or its equivalent, with a cumulative GPA not less than 2.50.

2) Good behavioral manners, healthy, no disabilities that impede practice in the nursing and midwifery profession, and no color blindness deficiency.

2.2 Specific Qualifications of Applicant

1) The height is not less than 150 centimeters, or 4.9 feet and BMI does not exceed 27 Kilograms per square meter.

2) Passing at least one of the English language proficiency tests specified by the faculty of Nursing as follows:

ii. Any other cases that do not qualify the requirements, will be considered under the discretion of Princess Agra Rajakumari College of Nursing, Chulabhorn Royal Academy.

3. Application for Admission

3.1 Application Period

1) Applicants for Additional Direct Admission should familiarize themselves with the application registration procedure and complete the online information form on the website (http://reg.cra.erp.ac.th/cra_erp_equ/admission/). Between **May 8th 2024 onwards**.

3.2 Submitted Application Procedures

Applicants should to complete the application and registration process online via the website: http://reg.cra.erp.ac.th/cra_erp_equ/admission/, following the steps outlined below:

3.2.1 Compete and submit the online application form along with the necessary documents within the specified application period. **Please be aware that applications cannot be resubmitted once completed.**

3.2.2 Supporting Documents:

1) Include a recent 1x1 inch digital photograph featuring a full face, formal attire, without head cover or glasses, taken within the last 6 months. The file format should be .jpg or .png and should not exceed 600 KB.

2) Provide a scanned copy of the national ID card:

3) Submit a scanned copy of the high school graduation certificate/ diploma for Mattayomsuksa 6 or Grade 12, in either Thai or English, or its foreign equivalent. If not in English, please provide the original document along with an official English translation.

4) Include a scanned copy of the official high school transcript in either Thai or English, or its foreign equivalent. If not in English, please provide the original document along with an official English translation.

5) Present any official certificate for English language proficiency such as TOEFL, IELTS, CU-TEP, or TU-GET.

6) For the Portfolio admission round, prepare a portfolio summarizing your data and upload it on the website. The portfolio should not exceed 10 pages and must include a cover page. (Please bring the portfolio to the interview).

7) If there has been a name change (either first name or last name) that does not match the name on your graduation certificate in 3.2.2.3, provide a certificate of name change along with your signature.

3.2.3 Print the following documents:

1) Applicant form

2) Payment slip for the application fee of 500 baht.

3) A printable Physical Examination Report obtained from a government hospital or a reliable private hospital (to be provided after being eligible for the interview).

3.2.4 Payment Methods: To proceed with your application, payments can be made through banking services or internet banking (in Thailand ONLY) or via over-the-counter services using the provided printable form from the system.

3.2.5 Completion of Application Procedure: The application procedure will be considered complete once the application fee has been successfully paid.

3.3 Application Fee

Application fee is 500 baht

4. Providing Application Documents on the Interview Date:

4.1 Submit the completed online application form, including a recent 1x1 inch photograph with a full face, formal dress (without head cover and glasses), taken within the last 6 months.

4.2 Provide a copy of the National ID card.

4.3 For Thai applicants, include a copy of your household registration.

4.4 For Thai applicants, include a copy of the parent's household registration or legal guardian's household registration.

4.5 For foreign applicants, submit a copy of your passport.

4.6 Include a copy of the certificate of name change if applicable.

4.7 Provide the payment slip for the application fee of 500 baht.

4.8 Include a copy of your high school graduation certificate/diploma.

4.9 If available, submit a letter of recommendation from your school principal or student advisor. The letter should be stamped by the school and should demonstrate your leadership qualifications.

4.10 Include a copy of your English proficiency test score.

4.11 Provide a physical examination report.

5. Announcement of Admission Results:

6. Scholarship:

To commemorate the 60th Birthday Anniversary of Princess Chulabhorn Walailak Agrarajakumari, a scholarship is offered to students at Princess Agra Rajakumari College of Nursing. It covers tuition and other fees, totaling approximately 68,750 baht per semester. Applicants are expected to contribute approximately 37,500 baht per semester (excluding the admission fee). This scholarship entails a conditional agreement, requiring recipients to work with Chulabhorn Royal Academy for a 4-year period post-graduation. In the event of contract cancellation, students will be responsible for paying tuition fees for an entire academic year.

7. Tuition and Other Fees

7.1 Entrance Fee (14,800 baht) consists of:

- Learning materials and activities fee (Nurse uniform, Nurse shoes, PE uniform, and university blazer, etc.)

- 10,000 baht

- 2,500 baht - Security deposit (Refundable)

- 2,000 baht

- Student ID card - 300 baht

7.2 Tuition Fee: The tuition fee is 37,500 baht per semester.

7.3 Applicants who choose not to receive the scholarship must pay the tuition fee of 106,250 baht per semester.

7.4 Graduation Fee (2,450 baht) consist of:

- Registration fee - 2,000 baht

- Pin fee - 250 baht - Bachelor's degrees Certificate - 200 baht

Note: A Student Loan Fund is available for international program student.
