Re : Application for Admission to the Bachelor of Nursing Science (International Program) for the Academic Year 2027 (For International Students)

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To ensure the orderly execution of the Princess Agrarajakumari Faculty of Nursing's admissions process for the Bachelor of Nursing Science (International Program) for the academic year 2027 (B.E. 2570),

By virtue of the authority granted under Clause 18 of the Regulations of Chulabhorn Royal Academy on Heads of Divisions, Divisional Committees, and Administration of Divisions of Chulabhorn Royal Academy B.E. 2568 (2025); Clause 6 of the Announcement of the HRH Princess Chulabhorn College of Medical Science regarding the Administrative Structure of the Faculty of Nursing, dated May 2, 2017 (B.E. 2560), and in accordance with the Chulabhorn Royal Academy's Order No. 11/2025 (B.E. 2568), on the Appointment of the Acting Dean of the Princess Agrarajakumari Faculty of Nursing, dated January 3, 2025 (B.E. 2568), as well as the resolution passed at the 1/2025 meeting of the Chulabhorn Royal Academy Council held on January 10, 2025 (B.E. 2568), the Princess Agrarajakumari Faculty of Nursing hereby announces the call for applications from international students for admission to the Bachelor of Nursing Science (International Program) for the academic year 2027 (B.E. 2570), with details as follows:

1. Number of Acceptance

30 students

2. Application Period

1 September 2026 - 31 May 2027

Applications will be reviewed on a rolling, first-come, first-served basis.

3. Admission Criteria

3.1 Qualifications for International Applicants

International applicants are applicants who are not Thai nationals, including applicants who completed upper secondary education in Thailand but do not hold a Thai national identification card or Thai passport. Applicants must meet the following criteria:

3.1.1 Demonstrate appropriate conduct and be in good health; have no underlying medical conditions, no mental health problems, no color vision deficiency, and no disabilities that would hinder study, professional nursing practice, or midwifery practice.

3.1.2 Have a height of not less than 150 centimeters and a body mass index (BMI) of 18–25 kg/m².

3.1.3 Meet at least one of the following English language proficiency criteria:

English Test	Minimum Score
TOEFL (PBT)	≥ 450
TOEFL (iBT)	≥ 60
TOEFL (ITP)	≥ 450
IELTS	≥ 5
CEFR	≥ B2

Applicants who are native English speakers or who have completed formal education in English may be exempted from the English proficiency requirement.

3.1.4 Have graduated from or be studying in the final semester of Matthayom Suksa 6 (M.6), Grade 12, or an equivalent upper secondary education qualification under one of the following conditions:

3.1.4.1 Applicants who graduated from an international school in Thailand

- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 3.00. For applicants who are currently studying, the CGPA shall be calculated from five semesters. For applicants who have already graduated, the CGPA shall be calculated from six semesters.

- Have completed Chemistry, Biology, and Mathematics, with a minimum CGPA of 3.00 in each subject.

3.1.4.2 Applicants who graduated from an overseas institution or hold an equivalent secondary education qualification

Applicants must have qualifications under one of the following secondary education equivalency systems:

British System

- General Certificate of Education Advanced Level (GCE A Level) with grade results of A*–E in at least three different subjects; or
- Cambridge Pre-U with grade results of M1 or D1–D3 in at least three different subjects.

American System

- General Educational Development (GED) credential obtained before May 2017, with a minimum total score of 2,250 across all five subjects and at least 410 points in each subject; or
- General Educational Development (GED) credential obtained from May 2017 onward, with a minimum score of 145 in each of the four subjects.

New Zealand System

- National Certificate of Educational Achievement (NCEA) Record of Achievement with at least 80 credits achieved, comprising 60 credits at Level 2 or above and 20 credits at Level 1 or above, with English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) considered as a subject; and

- Applicants must submit the NCEA Level 2 certificate, Record of Achievement, level certification letter, list of subjects, and number of credits for each subject issued by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA).

International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP)

- International Baccalaureate Diploma with a total score of at least 24 points from five subjects and one free elective. Applicants must pass the Extended Essay (EE), Theory of Knowledge (TOK), and Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS) requirements in accordance with the criteria of the International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO); or

- IB Diploma Course Results (IBCR) with a grade of not less than 3 in at least five different subjects.

Other High School Diplomas

- High school diploma from an international school in Thailand with an equivalency certificate issued by the Ministry of Education, Thailand; or

- High school diploma from an international school overseas with an equivalency certificate issued by the Ministry of Education, Thailand.

Note

- For education systems from countries not mentioned above, applicants should consult the foreign academic qualification equivalency information provided by the Association of The Council of University Presidents of Thailand at www.mytcas.com.

- Applicants who submit an equivalency document or other standard certification must provide evidence of completion of Chemistry, Biology, and Mathematics, either through their academic transcript or standardized test results.

3.1.5 Any cases that do not meet the specified qualifications may be considered at the discretion of the Princess Agrarajakumari Faculty of Nursing, Chulabhorn Royal Academy.

4. Application Procedures

Applicants must complete all required information, upload the necessary documents, and submit the online application by the specified deadline via the admission system: <https://nurseinter.cra.ac.th>.

5. Required Documents

5.1 A 1x1 inch photo taken no more than 6 months.

5.2 A copy of the applicant's passport.

5.3 A copy of all high school certificates and transcripts (must be uploaded as a single PDF file; if the documents are not in English, please submit the original documents along with an official English translation).

5.4 A copy of a valid English proficiency test score.

5.5 A copy of certificate of name change (if applicable).

5.6 A completed physical examination report (to be submitted before the interview).

6. Application Fee

7. Interviews

Qualified applicants will be invited to an interview, which will be conducted either at the Princess Agrarajakumari Faculty of Nursing, Chulabhorn Royal Academy, or

online. The interview schedule will be announced after the application review, and all interviews will be conducted no later than June 2027.

8. Announcement of Accepted Applicants

Successful applicants will be announced on a rolling basis following the completion of their interviews. All admission results will be announced no later than June 2027.

9. Tuition and Fees
